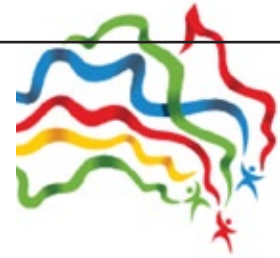


# Australia Day
